

ARTICLE 27. I move that the Town vote to support a resolution as distributed at the 2012 Annual Town Meeting to call upon the United States Congress to pass and send to the states for ratification a constitutional amendment to reverse the Supreme Court's decision in *Citizens United v. Federal Elections Commission* and to restore democracy to the people.

VOTE: YES - 118 NO - 7

ARTICLE 28. I move that the Town vote to raise and appropriate ~~XXXXX~~ to increase the Stabilization Fund as defined in Chapter 40, section 5B of the General Laws. **Withdraw article**

VOTE: YES- NO-
(two-thirds vote required)

ARTICLE 29. I move that the Town vote to transfer from Free Cash a sum of \$750,000 for the purpose of lowering the property tax rate.


VOTE: YES - 125 NO - 0
